




The "Nürburgring" presents some superlatives and therefore not only Stirling Moss calls it the most difficult circuit of the world.

The Northern Circuit of the "Ring" (see drawing by Prof. Hitzler) is the longest circuit of the world (22,835 km), consists of more than 150 curves and shows an exact altitude difference of 300 meters (starting/finishing area 620 m — Breidscheid 320 m). No wonder that one will find ascents up to 17% and descents of 11%. The fastest lap on the Northern Circuit was reached by Chris Amon with a Ferrari (17.57 min. = 172.22 km/h).

The lap record of the ADAC-1000-km-races stands at 8.33 min. (= 180.2 km/h) reached by the last year's winner Jo Siffert with a Porsche 908.
